Welcome

Hello and Welcome to St. Paul's Catholic School.

School Entrance

This is the school main entrance where you will enter at the start of the day. School registration starts at 8.50am but the site is open from 7.30am.





Main Reception

This is the main reception (just above the entrance) where someone will always be at the desk. It opens at 7.30am and closes at 5.15pm (4.15pm Fridays). They are very friendly and can answer any questions you might have.

School Library (Learning Resource Centre)

At the library plenty of fiction and non-fiction books are available to loan and there is also lots of space to read or study. We even have some computers to use too. The library opens at 7.30 and stays open after school too.





The Chapel

The Chapel is a place where students are able to go and pray or just have a quiet space to come and reflect. If students are ever concerned or feel they need to talk with someone we also have a wonderful pastoral team who are always available.

The Main Base

The Main base for Emmaus Support is situated above the library. Here you may do catch up sessions on literacy or numeracy, reading groups or independent study time. There are always ESAs and staff around to help you or answer any questions.







The Communication Base

This is the Communication Base. It is a space prioritised for those with Autism. Interventions are run in here as well as there being a couple of PCs for study. It is also open before school and at break and lunch times so there is a quiet space for students to come in their social time including some break out spaces if required.

The VI Base

Here is the VI Base. Staff work hard to adapt resources for students who need this and sessions are run in here for those students too.







The HI Base

The HI Base is located in the library and sessions are run in here for those with any hearing needs. There are also sessions for any pupil in the school that may want to learn BSL.



The Office

This is where the Emmaus Support Office is and staff will always be available if you have questions.

There is an accessible toilet available near the library and students are welcome to use this. The key is kept in the Emmaus Support Office.
