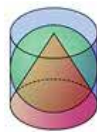
»» Vision for Curriculum

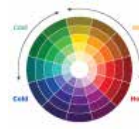
The Art department aims to foster critical and creative thinking, artistic expression, effective communication and develop their cultural capital.

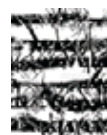
