

The Destination Programme

June - July

- Investigate pathways university, apprenticeships, jobs
- Start investigating university courses
- Write their first draft of their personal statement in the Unifrog software
- Complete the first 11 sections of their personal details on UCAS

<u>September - December</u>


- Early applications for Oxford, Cambridge, Medicine, Veterinary Medicine, and Dentistry to be completed by October
- All other applications to be completed by the end of December

• One application per admissions cycle. Maximum five choices (some restrictions). Application fee £28.50

• We set internal deadlines at least x2 weeks (working days) before these dates to ensure that there is sufficient time for checking and references to be completed before it is sent off.

THIS MEANS NO LATER THAN 15th JANUARY IF YOU ARE TO MEET THE UCAS DEADLINE!!!!



Key facts







Universities and colleges can't see your other choices when you apply.



Apply by the **equal** consideration date.



Five choices, unless applying to study medicine, veterinary, medicine/science, dentistry – then it's four choices.



You can't apply to both Oxford and Cambridge.



Applying costs £28.50.


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Researching Courses




Check the deadlines for admissions tests

Some courses have extra admissions tests and assessments.

We'll show these in **blue text** on the choice card.

This should not be a surprise to you, as you should have seen details of this when researching the course.



You will need to complete these at assessment centres. Check and book in time for applications. Some are free. Please check.





PPE's and Predicted Grades

- Predicted grades are used for university and apprenticeship applications.
- Predicted grades are determined by the progress a student is making in their studies and are based on actual grades obtained in both external and internal assessments throughout year 12. These are not target grades on PCs.
- PPE's are important. Use them when searching for suitable courses.
- PPE week 19-26 June. Students expected back in lessons from the 27th of June





Parents what you can do next?

- Engage and support students to search for appropriate courses. Explore universities and apprenticeships.
- Engage with the process of writing the first draft of the personal statement.
- Give positive feedback.
- Keep in touch with the mentors through mentoring evenings and emails.
- Support visits to universities.
- Encourage wider reading/work around their chosen field.
- Begin to research Finance support and discuss with your children the importance of budgeting!!!
- Consider and research immigration status if appropriate



How can I apply?

- Applications are made directly through the company or the education provider.
- There is no limit on the number of applications you can make.
- The application process might vary across vacancies, you could be asked for:
 - CV and Covering Letter
 - Application Form
 - In App/Site application
- Advertised throughout the year.
- No single deadline.
