

# KS5 Progress check – Explanatory Notes

## How is classroom effort assessed?

Classroom Effort (CE) is measured on a scale of 1 – 4

- 4 The pupil always works beyond the expectations of St. Paul's.
- 3 The pupil always meets the expectations of St. Paul's and sometimes works beyond this.
- 2 The pupil occasionally fails to meet the expectations of St. Paul's.
- 1 The pupil consistently fails to meet the expectations of St. Paul's and is content with doing the minimum required

## How is homework reported?

Homework is measured on a scale of 1 – 4:

- 4. **Each** piece of homework set during the assessment period has been completed to an exceptional standard.
- 3. **Each** piece of homework set during the assessment period has been completed to the required standard.
- 2. **One or Two** pieces of homework set during the assessment period do not meet the required standard.
- 1. **More** than two pieces of homework set during the assessment period do not meet the required standard.

Please note that if a pupil is absent from school on the day that a piece of homework is set, then it is his/her responsibility to ensure that work is collected from the teacher or from the online calendar and a new deadline negotiated if required.

### The Assessment Periods are:

Beginning of the Academic Year to PC1

PC1 to PC2

PC2 to PC3

## How are the Minimum Expected Grades calculated?

These are minimum expected grades for the end of KS5 (or the end of the programme if it's a one year course) and are externally calculated using GCSE performance. The minimum expected grades are set to put the school in the top 25% of schools for progress at Key Stage 5.

## How are subject progress and key learning skills assessed?

Years 12 & 13

At Post 16 we use the grade system used by exam boards for particular courses, and measure progress against expected outcomes at Year 13. The grades for courses are indicated below. Each grade has integers from 1 – 9 with one being the lowest. This will help parents, pupils and teachers track progress through a grade.
